




5. Once you have completed this, select the 'Register' button in red and the page will show a message to let you know you have successfully created an account, select 'Ok'.




6. You will now be re-directed to the login page where you can login to the site using your new username (e-mail) and password.




1. From the dashboard – select the category 'Programs Accredited by the RACGP'








Fill out the rsvp form in the new tab or browser window and select 'Submit' then close the new tab or window by selecting the close 'x' button to return to the ResMed Academy Online





3. Select the program category link 'Recognising and Managing Sleep Apnea in Primary Care' and click on the 'Register' button for the program







4. Click Next and Submit







5. Select the 'Start' button to resume the modules






6. When the course has ended select the close 'x' button on the window and you will be directed to the activity details screen where the other modules in the curriculum sit
